Entrance Requirements for New Students Entering Grade 1-6

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The following are State of Massachusetts mandated requirements that must be provided to St. Francis Xavier School upon acceptance.

DTP/DTap	≥4or more doses or
Td	≥3 or more
Polio	≥3 doses
MMR	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella (Chicken Pox)	1 dose or MD proof of disease (date required)
Lead Level	physician documentation
Copy of physical exam	dated after September 1, 2009

Please have your child's doctor complete a physical form with immunization included. The physical must be dated after September 1, 2009 and returned to school upon acceptance. If you currently have a copy of the physical dated after September 1, 2009 please send it in to school prior to the end of this school year. If you do not have a current physical, please see your child's physician. All documentation must be received by **August 15, 2010.**

In addition, State law mandates that no medicine can be administered in school without written authorization from the child's parent and doctor. This policy applies to all medicine, even Tylenol, Benadryl, and inhalers. If you anticipate your child needing any medication during the school year, please contact the office for a medication authorization form or download the form from the website.

If your child has significant allergies or any other medical condition, please make an appointment to see me prior to the beginning of the school year. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the school. Thank you for your assistance.
