## **New Student Registration grades 7 and 8**

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The following are State of Massachusetts mandated requirements that must be provided to St. Francis Xavier School prior to the start of Grade 7 and 8

<b>DTP/DTap</b>	<b>≥4or more doses or</b>
<b>Td</b>	<b>≥3 or more:plus Td booster</b>
<b>Polio</b>	<b>≥3 doses</b>
<b>MMR</b>	<b>2 doses</b>
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	<b>3 doses</b>
<b>Varicella (Chicken Pox)</b>	<b>&lt;13-1dose dose ≥13-2 doses or MD proof of disease (date required)</b>
<b>Copy of physical exam</b>	<b>dated after September 1, 2009</b>

Please have your child's doctor complete a physical form with immunization record, lead and vision screening included. The physical must be dated after September 1, 2009. Students without the required information will not be allowed to attend school. All documentation must be received by August 15, 2010.

In addition, State law mandates that no medicine can be administered in school without written authorization from the child's parent and doctor. This policy applies to all medicine, both over the counter and prescription. If you anticipate your child needing any medication during the school year, please contact the office for a medication authorization form or download the form from the school's website.

If your child has significant allergies or any other medical condition, please contact the office prior to the beginning of the school year. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the school.
